PAPER AND SYMPOSIA PRESENTATIONS

All of the paper presentation sessions are scheduled in one of the five presentation rooms: Carousel A, B, and C and Marquee I and II. Each of these presentations room will come equipped with the following audio-visual and computer set:

1 large white projection screen

1 overhead projector

1 LCD projector

1 Macintosh PowerBook with internal CD-ROM drive and Microsoft Office Suite PRO including Powerpoint

1 set of speakers
